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TEACHING CAREER IN BRIEF

I graduated from Eötvös Loránd University in 2020, where my mentor was Katalin Balázs and my methodology supervisor was Luca Szalay. My first workplace was Kovács Pál Baptist Secondary School, whose primary educational focus was preparing student athletes for their secondary school leaving examinations. As a result, chemistry teaching there mainly involved helping students catch up to the basic level requirements. Following this, I joined the Premontrei School Centre, first as a part-time teacher and later in a full-time position, where I began working with students specializing in chemistry. At the Premonstratensian School Centre, I prepared students from grades 7–12 for numerous academic competitions within the framework of advanced classes, regular lessons, specialized chemistry tracks, and extracurricular study groups, including the Curie Chemistry Competition, Irinyi János National Chemistry Competition, National Secondary School Academic Competition, and Bolyai Team Competition. Currently, I am completing my professional teaching qualification at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics with a specialization in educational measurement and evaluation.
