TEACHING CAREER IN BRIEF

I established my teaching career with a degree in Biology and Chemistry from the József Attila University (now University of Szeged). A defining part of my professional identity is the three decades I spent at the Mátyás Corvin Secondary Vocational School of Trade and Catering in Hódmezővásárhely, where I taught biology, chemistry, and food science. Since 2020, I have been a member of the faculty at the Németh László Grammar School and Primary School in Hódmezővásárhely, where I currently teach biology and chemistry, with a strong focus on preparing students for advanced-level final examinations.

The core of my pedagogical philosophy is practice-oriented education. I am convinced that a commitment to natural sciences is best deepened through laboratory experience. In this spirit, I regularly lead chemistry clubs and play an active role in the work of the János Selye Student Laboratory Network, where I introduce students to the world of experimentation through regular laboratory sessions. Talent management is an integral part of my work: I successfully prepare upper-year students for chemistry competitions and younger students for complex natural science contests.

My professional standing is reflected in my role as an examiner for the oral entrance examinations at the Faculty of Dentistry of the University of Szeged. This position provides me with direct insight into university requirements and the selection process for the next generation of professionals.
