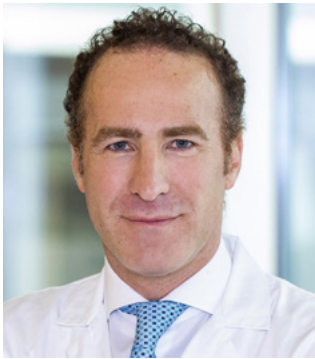


SHAHROKH SHARIAT



Professor **Shahrokh F. Shariat, MD**, is Professor and Chair of Urology at the Medical University of Vienna and President of the Austrian and Central European Urological Societies. He is a leading surgeon-scientist with over 2000 publications and internationally recognized for his contributions to urologic oncology and cancer research.

ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Professor Shahrokh F. Shariat is Professor and Chair of the Department of Urology at the Medical University of Vienna, where he also serves as the Head of the Comprehensive Cancer Center Vienna. In addition, he is also the President of both the Austrian Urological Society and the Central European Urological Society, underlining his leadership in advancing clinical practice and research across Europe.

Professor Shariat completed his medical education and training at several distinguished institutions, including the University of Vienna, the University of La Laguna, the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, Baylor College of Medicine, UT Southwestern Medical Center and Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. He holds adjunct and honorary professorships at Weill Cornell University in New York, UT Southwestern in Dallas, Charles University in Prague, the University of Jordan in Amman and Tabriz Medical University.

His scientific achievements are internationally recognized. He has published more than 2000 peer-reviewed articles, over 600 non-peer-reviewed contributions, more than 30 book chapters and 2000 abstracts. His work has received more than 77000 citations, reflected in a Scopus h-index of 134. He is an active member of 25 academic societies and has served on 26 editorial boards.

Professor Shariat's contributions have been acknowledged through numerous honors, including Doctor Honoris Causa from Semmelweis University and Carol Davila University, the Gold Cystoscope Award of the American Urological Association and the Crystal Matula Award of the European Association of Urology. He also holds several patents for prognostic methods in prostate and bladder cancer, highlighting his commitment to innovation in cancer detection and management.

Professor Shariat is an inspirational speaker who, at the XXIII Meeting of Nobel Laureates and Talented Students in Szeged (2024), delivered a highly insightful lecture on building a fulfilling and successful academic career in the health sciences. His passion and commitment to excellence shine through in everything he does and says.
